## Member Groups

Member Groups are usually led by locals, and often informal such as small businesses, families, church groups, or social organizations.

- 👉 Membership is free.
- 👉 Groups are required to participate in the life of the Network.

## Supporting Groups

Supporting Groups usually want to broadcast their practical support of "community." They are often large organizations, based outside Bayview Hunters Point, citywide in nature, chain businesses or government agencies.

- 👉 A financial or in-kind contribution to the Network is requested.
- 👉 Supporters are listed year-round.
